

Xccent Stand Alone Play Assemblies Limited Warranty Statement



Xccent Stand Alone Play Assembly PVC coated steel components are warranted for a period of five (5) years from the date of purchase, against any defects of workmanship under normal use and service, rot, fungal deterioration and significant color fade.

Xccent Stand Alone Play Assembly moving parts including, but not limited to: flexible polymer hinges, legs & components, torsion axels, etc. are warranted for a period of three (3) years from the date of purchase, against any defects of workmanship or failures under normal use and service.

This warranty does not include damage or excessive wear due to vandalism, incidents of improper use and handling or improper installation. Improper installation is defined as installation that does not strictly abide by the instructions set forth by Xccent.

This warranty is non-transferable and is valid only for the original purchaser and installation of Xccent Stand Alone Play Assembly equipment.

Xccent will repair or replace on a prorated basis all parts which fail as foresaid. All freight and installation charges are to be paid by the end user and are not the responsibility of Xccent.
